MUTUAL NON-DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT

[Energy Technology Corp (its subsidiaries), with offices located at Energy House, 1 Bayview Terrace, 31 Hallow Jersey, 08210 A, for itself and its affiliates ("ETL"), and Energy Group for itself and her affiliates ("Company"), in consideration of the mutual covenants of this Agreement, hereby agree as follows:]

- In connection with ongoing discussions between ETL and Company concerning possible transactions ("Transactions"), each party to this Agreement may wish to disclose certain proprietary and confidential information to the other party on a confidential basis. Each proprietary or confidential information ("Confidential Information") includes without limitation all technical or non-technical information, financial, accounting, or marketing data, business plans, analyses, forecasts, projections, or projections, intellectual property, trade secrets, or know-how; personal, financial, or account information of end users, and reports, analysis, studies, or other materials containing or based upon Confidential Information. Confidential Information may take the form of documents, drawings, specifications, software, technical, or engineering data, or other physical or electronic writings.
- "Representatives" means the controlled affiliates of either party, and the respective directors, officers, employees, attorneys, contractors, consultants, and other agents and advisors of either party or of the controlled affiliates of either party. Each party shall be responsible for any breach of this Agreement by its respective Representatives and shall take all reasonably necessary measures to restrict its Representatives from the unauthorized disclosure or use of Confidential Information.
- All Confidential Information disclosed in connection with the Transactions shall be deemed confidential and subject to this Agreement unless otherwise confirmed in writing by the disclosing party. Memorandum D11-11-3

Advance Rulings for Tariff Classification

In Brief

This memorandum has been revised to include:

- updates on the policy regarding the postponement of the effective date of an advance ruling and situations where an advance ruling will not be issued and the request rejected;
- new policies on the retention, disposal and the returning period of the advance ruling request and / or supporting literature and / or sample to the applicant;
- clarification on the 120 day service standard when the CBSA requests samples for laboratory analysis;
- clarification on an advance ruling request for a conditional relief tariff item; and,
- new procedures for the exchange of information by email between the applicant or their agent and the CBSA.

This memorandum outlines the Canada Border Services Agency's (CBSA) program for issuing advance rulings for tariff classification under paragraph 43.1(1)(c) of the [Customs Act](#).

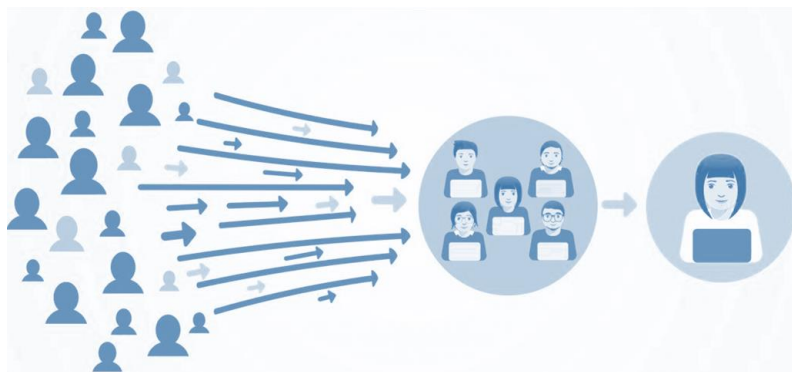
